

## 2024 Lingleville Youth Sports Basketball League Rules/Regulations

The League is formed to help foster the skills of basketball and a love for the game. The League will be governed by a collective Board of Commissioners from Lingleville. Games will be held each Saturday January 27<sup>th</sup> through March 9<sup>th</sup>.

- Rules for each division have been approved by League Commissioners. Each Coach will be provided a listing of all rules. Additional copies may be requested.
- Coaches must be 18 years of age or older, unless partnered with an adult. All coaches must submit to and pass a background check. Records of those results will be held by the Commissioner of their team. Coaches must agree and follow all division and league rules.
- All Player fees will be determined by the Commissioner of each location.
- Grade/Age/Affiliation Determination – age groups are based on grade level that the player is currently in for the 2023-2024 school year. All players must be able to provide proof of affiliation with team by location, if requested. A current report card must be included in each team binder for every player. Players can play up a division but not down. If a player's grade level or affiliation is challenged and cannot be provided, player will be benched for the remainder of the game.
- Players must meet the uniform requirements of their team.
- Game jerseys/t-shirts must display a number on the front and back – numbers can be 0-15, 20-25, 30-35, 40-45 and 50-55. No 6, 7, 8 & 9. (Single digits.)
- Games will be held in Lingleville. Concessions will be available.
- There will not be a gate fee for entry.
- The League fees to be paid by all teams will include ref fees at a rate of \$25/game and a facility use fee (cleaning). Lingleville Youth Sports will not retain any funds received but will only use fees to pay expenses.
- The game location does NOT furnish warm up balls, only GAME balls.
- Lingleville will provide someone to run the time clock and a bookkeeper (all teams should keep books during the games.) The Commissioner from each location must approve of the time clock and bookkeeper.
- There will be a League Commissioner, for the host location, present at all games.
- Only 2 coaches will be allowed on the bench.
- There will be 2 officials required for each game. An adult official is required at every game. Children younger than 18 years of age, must be partnered with an adult.
- The youngest teams of the league will start the day.
- There will be 5 minutes between games.
- All teams (coaches and players) are requested to be on location 30 minutes prior to their game start time. All players need to be stretched and ready for warm up.
- Anyone that does not follow the rules/regulations of the League will be subject to disciplinary action from the League and risks removal from their position.
